Teacher Representative Report ~ Jen Abbott - teachers were very thankful for the staff luncheon. Principal's Report ~ Mrs. Bali - thanked PTA for our support, especially grateful for postponing the ice cream social since we had rising case #s. Roopali wants to get to a place where families can safely be back on campus and involved. Recognized that everyone has been so flexible with the changes. There was a fire drill yesterday and the school beat the previous record of 7 min with a 6 min finish time. Mentioned the principal's coffee that will be held on 9/1 from 9-10am via zoom, a link will be sent out. Tatiana resigned last night, she has been so helpful w/Roopali's transition and will be greatly missed.

Parliamentarian's Report ~ Karen Halm

Bylaws to be updated this year - Bylaws need to be updated this year. Karen passed out a copy
of our current bylaws for review. Bylaws are to be updated every 5 years. Dec 31 is the deadline.
Most rules won't change, Karen noted some small changes, such as adding zoom meetings.
Once we finalize changes, we approve them, then pass them to the district and then the state to
get approved. Committee formed is Karen, Annalisa and Amy.

President's Report ~ Annalisa Graham

 - All Executive Board members are required to purchase a Family Membership for the 2021-2022 school year - can be planned on FF and will get a link for teachers to use

- Has teacher membership form been circulated to teachers?
- Music position funds there was a long discussion about this topic. There are a couple of important facts to note 1) the District is having issues filling any part-time positions, such as paras and subs. There are many unfilled para positions right now. 2) This position hasn't been filled at Rancho is years, as it's very "part-time." The position was posted on May 1 over Edjoin. The position was posted again last week. Anyone w/alternative ideas on how to bring music to Rancho perhaps outdoor "concerts"/assemblies? Other parents offered to reach out to former music teachers (Teri, Qali and Katie.) Maybe word of mouth? The position is 16 hours/wk. Music is different from band because band is a certificated teacher, whereas music would be more of an instructional assistant, so music isn't a prep period for the teacher, teachers have to stay with their class during music. Band is only offered to 4th/5th graders. Parent groups are not allowed to be involved with hiring or firing staff. For now, we agreed to leave the \$17,000 with the school.
 - PTA donated \$17,000 to school to fund a music position for 2021-2022 school year
 - No one has applied for the position >> school willing to return the funds to PTA
 - Do we want to utilize the returned funds for another music program? >> would need to be parent-organized
 - Funds could also be used for another project at Rancho
- Run Club as of now will not be in place for, at least, fall of 2021 no volunteers, plus with an 8am start time, Run Club would have to start too early in the morning.
- Still significant need for noon duty volunteers >> sign up using this link

 replacement for herself (as President.) Have received a lot of donations already, especially for the
 shade structure, working with the District to get it ordered and installed. In the meantime, some
 dads were going to volunteer to set up temporary shade structure over the picnic tables.
- Spirit wear store ~ Julie Rossing Will be live on the online store in Sept. Info to go out via email.
 They'll be adding a water bottle, hat and tie dye apparel. Working with a new vendor. This is not a
 money maker for the school, PTA is just helping facilitate for the school.
