ELECTION RESULTS FOR 2019-2020

COMPREHENSIVE SCHOOL SAFETY PLAN

Sandy gave the site council an update on the on the Comprehensive School Safety Plan (CSSP) for the upcoming school year. The CSSP will be published on the Rancho website and is also submitted to the State of CA.

Highlights Sandy covered from the plan are as follows:

- Rancho had the goal of raising attendance to 97% from 95.91% in the 2018/2019 school year. Our average daily attendance was 96.4%/. This is still one of the highest absenteeism rates in the district.
- We exceeded our goal for 3-5th grade CAASP testing: 100% attendance and tested. Sandy attributed our success to communication efforts from the teachers and administration.
- Suspension Rate 2 in 2019 down from 5 in 2018
- Report on Bullying zero reported to district from our website
- Reports on Internet Misuse 2 in 2019
- 98% of students feel safe on campus, surpassed goal of 95%
- Mobility started at 478, ended at 477 (7 added/8 dropped)
- Office Referrals (to principal by teacher or lunch duty supervisor): incident report/witnesses called in as well sandy always informs parents if their child was in the office. 21 incidents in 2019 up from 17 in 2018
- Student Success Team Meetings 48 meetings in 2019, to discuss any intervention or extension as part of RTI and snapshots
